Body Wear

- Thermal Underwear (2 tops & 1 bottom)
- Lightweight Fleece Top (micro/100 weight)
- Fleece, Primaloft or Softshell Jacket (~200 weight)
- Warm Climbing/Fleece Pants (100-200 weight)
- Down Jacket
- Gore-Tex Jacket & Pants
- Underwear and Socks
- Snow Gaiters

Head Wear

- Baseball hat or sun hat
- Woollen hat/fleece hat
- Balaclava
- Sun Glasses
- Snow Goggles
- Scarf or Bandanna

Hand Wear

- Mountaineering gloves with removable liner
- Finger / Liner gloves
- Fleece finger gloves

Camping Gear & Accessories

- Down Sleeping Bag (4 season or 700+ gms down fill)
- Water Bottle (2 litres)
- Headlamp + Spare Batteries
- Camera and batteries
- Sun Block & Lip Cream (plus spare)
- Toilet Bag (wet wipes, moisturiser, pack towel, medications)
- Small First Aid Kit (blister tape, 2nd skin, strapping tape, painkillers, anti-inflammatories etc)
- Down booties / comfortable boots for BC
- Note pad and pencil
- Pocket knife / Leatherman / Tool Kit
- Stuff Sacks and plastic bags

Optional Extras

- Thermos flask
- Map and compass
- Ear Plugs
- Avalanche Transceiver, shovel and probe and snowshoes if you have them (supplied FOC)
- Trekking Poles and snowshoes if you have them
- Chemical Hand/Toe Warmers
- Personal Entertainment

All of the above items except those marked optional, are necessary for mountaineering in New Zealand. Due to the variable weather and conditions in the NZ Mountains some of the above items may or may not be utilised on your trip.
